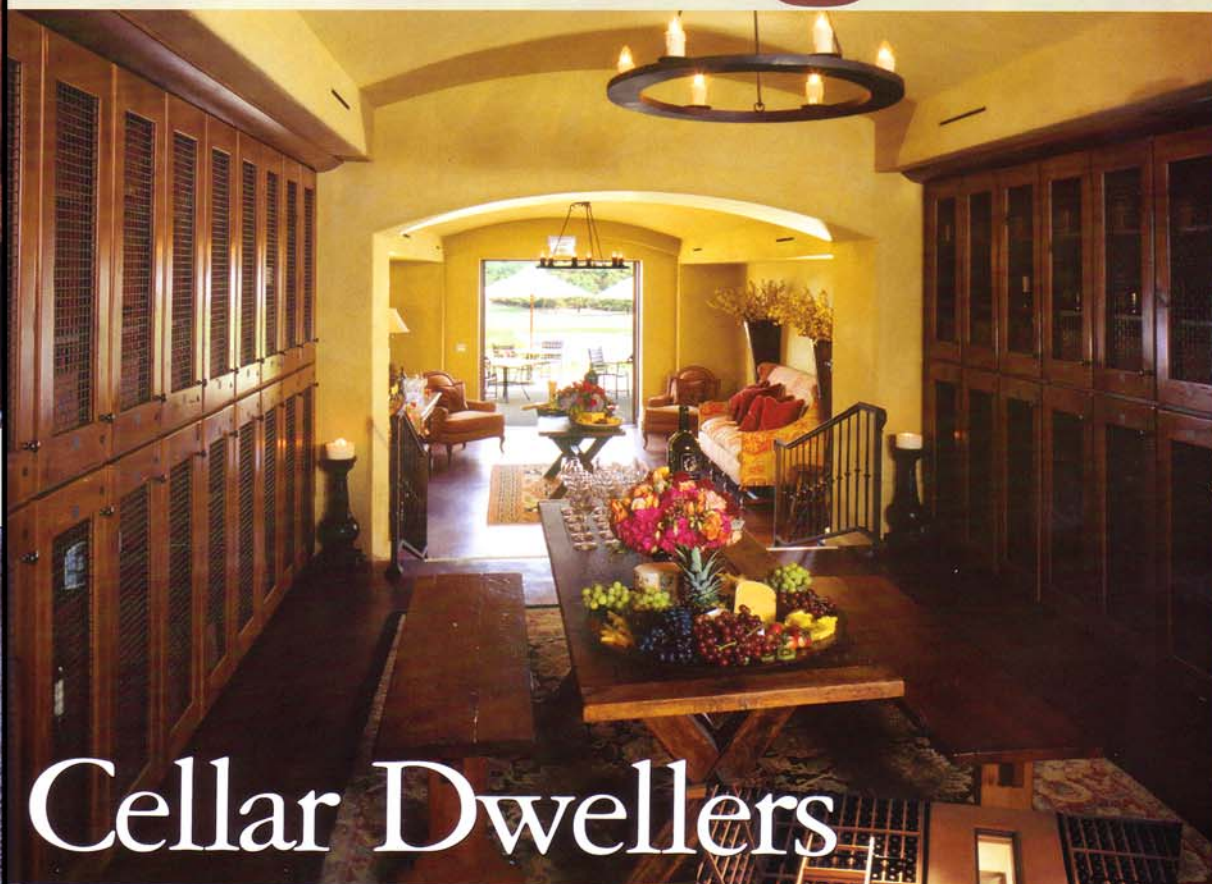

Mayacama's 40,000-square-foot clubhouse houses a cavernous wine cellar and an underground wine grotto, where every member receives a personal custom-made wine locker.

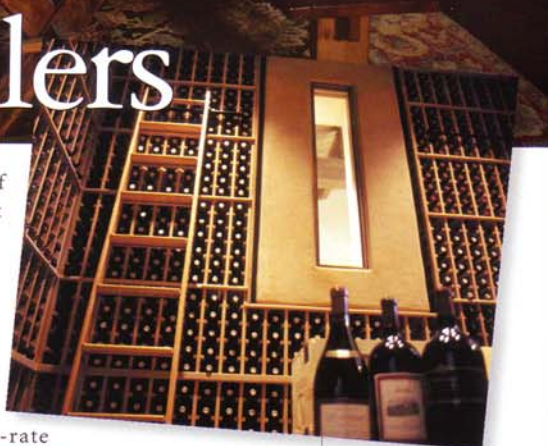
In addition, 29 local wineries offer members preferred pricing, exclusive products and special events, as well as barrels of premier vintages.

While there is a natural connection between golf and wine in Sonoma, other communities around the country are responding to the demand for wine and the good life.

Members of The Club at Carlton Woods near Houston share a similar passion for golf and grapes. Following a round on one of the club's two first-rate

courses, members can retire to the Tuscan Room, which recreates an authentic Italian wine cellar and is the site of gourmet dinners and wine tastings arranged by the club's executive chef and two resident sommeliers.
